### Process for Ordering a Low-Dose CT Lung Screen

1. Complete Derry Imaging Lung Screening Requisition. If using your own order form please ensure the following are met:
  - The patient meets criteria for (Medicare or Private Insurance) listed on our requisition, and shared decision making has occurred CPT (G-0296)
  - The correct CPT code is used (G-0297)
  - The correct ICD-10 Code is used
    - o **Z87.891** (*former smoker*) Personal history-nicotine dependence;
    - o **F17.210** (*current smoker*) Nicotine dependence, cigarettes, uncomplicated
    - o **F17.211** Nicotine dependence, cigarettes, in remission
    - o **F17.213** Nicotine dependence, cigarettes, w/ withdrawal
    - o **F17.218** Nicotine dependence, cigarettes, w/ other nicotine-induced disorders
    - o **F17.219** Nicotine dependence, cigarettes, w/ unspecified nicotine-induced disorders
  - The Prior Auth is done with the correct codes listed above.

**WARNING – if this process is not followed, there is a strong chance the patient could get billed for the full amount of the CT Lung Screening.**

2. Fax completed order to (603) 310-0206
3. Lung Screening Patient Navigator will contact the patient to get them scheduled
  - Once the appointment has been scheduled the Navigator will fax the order back to the ordering provider with the appointment date and time written in on the bottom of the order
  - If a Prior Auth is required, we will book the patient out 2 weeks and let you know ASAP so you have time to obtain the PA.
