

DMC PRIMARY CARE TO OPEN IN NEW WINDHAM LOCATION

After years of carefully planned construction on the corner of Hardwood Rd and Route 111, Windham residents will soon see the completion of one of the community's largest healthcare developments. DMC Primary Care, formerly Derry Medical Center, is preparing to relocate its Windham practice from Castle Commons to their newly built, two story 38,000 square foot outpatient medical facility at 7 Indian Rock Road. The practice has an anticipated opening in mid-September.

Prior to the building's completion members of the DMC leadership team gave an intimate explanation of the road ahead. The facility is intended to expand access to healthcare and improve the patient experience by bringing primary and specialty providers together in one location. In addition to DMC the building will house Derry Imaging Center, Spindel Eye Associates, Dermatology and Skin Health, Pinnacle Physical Therapy, Labcorp, NH Orthopedic, Lindner Dental Associates and Granite State Gastroenterology. DMC officials noted that while these providers will operate within the same newly designed facility, Derry Imaging is the only medical group directly partnered with DMC Primary Care. The remaining practices are independent private organizations that have established a lasting relationship with DMC and their patients through years of trusted specialty medical care. The new DMC Windham building will continue to support current patient needs while also allowing for future growth and expansion. With locations in eight NH communities, DMC has become a reliable source for medical care within Southern New Hampshire and beyond, setting themselves apart from other practices with their emphasis on accessibility and holistic coordinated care. The region can also look forward to behavioral health care, patient education programs, employment opportunities and community events.

The building's design will blend modern medical functionality with architectural elements that offer connections to nature, including a welcoming atrium and office spaces that provide ample natural light. Project planners said the attention given to both aesthetic and functional details aim to improve patient flow and overall experience. With construction in its final stages, DMC Primary Care expects to begin welcoming patients in September, marking the next phase in the organization's presence in Windham and expanding access to healthcare services within the community and surrounding region.
